

Minimum Requirements for NPAP Evaluations

as of 4/1/24

Note: All NPAP evaluations are in the format of a conversation between a committee of NPAP members and an individual candidate. In all evaluations the candidate must demonstrate the ability to communicate effectively in English. This includes the ability to use English to understand and be understood, in nuanced clinical situations.

READINESS FOR CLINICAL PRACTICE EVALUATION (RCP)

- Completion of two full semesters of coursework, to include Introduction to Psychoanalytic Theory (IPT), Professional Ethics in Psychoanalytic Practice (R665), Case Presentations by Guest Analysts (R660A), and two other twelve-week 600-level courses.
- Completion of 60 hours of Personal Analysis at 3 times per week
- *Completion of a two-hour online course in the identification and reporting of child abuse.

Note: Candidates wishing to postpone the beginning of clinical work until they have completed the Matriculation Evaluation may apply to the Candidate Progress Committee for permission to do so.

MATRICULATION EVALUATION

- Completion of all courses on the 600 level of training
- Completion of 250 hours of Personal Analysis at 3 times per week

READINESS FOR CONTROL EVALUATION (RFC)

- Completion of all courses on the 600 and 700 levels
- Completion of the Matriculation Evaluation
- Completion of a minimum of 750 direct hours of clinical work
- Completion of a minimum of 50 hours of supervision with one supervisor on one case & a minimum of 100 hours of supervision with a second supervisor for LP candidates (non-LP candidates see Bulletin)
- Completion of 450 hours of Personal Analysis at 3 times per week

Note: Candidates applying for the NY License in Psychoanalysis will be eligible to apply for the limited permit after passing the RFC evaluation.

FINAL CASE EVALUATION (GRADUATION)

- Completion of all course work on the 600, 700 and 800 levels
- Completion of the Matriculation and RFC Evaluations
- Completion of a minimum of 1000 hours of direct clinical work with patients
- Completion of two control cases at a minimum of 3 times per week: one control for a min. of 100 supervisory hours and a second control for a min. of 50 supervisory hours with a different supervisor
- Completion of 450 hours of Personal Analysis at 3 times per week
