Training Costs:

Costs of the NPAP Psychoanalytic Training Program vary widely from candidate to candidate based on several variables, among them:

- The training track chosen by the candidate
- The length of time spent in the Psychoanalytic Training Program
- The ability of the candidate to find or negotiate reduced fees for supervision and personal psychoanalysis

Each applicant can estimate training costs for themselves based on the following information:

- Course work:
 - 32 12-week courses
 - 9 6-week courses
- The current cost per course is \$500 for 12 weeks; \$250 for 6 weeks.
- Annual Fee: All Candidates pay an annual registration fee as long as they remain in the program which, at this point, is \$250 per year.

Personal Psychoanalysis: Fee arrangements for personal psychoanalysis are made directly between the candidate and their analyst. These fees may vary widely.

- Many NPAP Members are willing to reduce fees considerably to help candidates in training.
- Fees may range from as low as \$50 per session to upwards of \$200 per session.
- It is recommended that candidates remain in some form of psychodynamic therapy or analysis throughout their training, and most candidates choose to do so. This will result in additional costs.

The supervised clinical experience portion of the training also varies widely depending on the training track of the candidate. Though the minimum program requirement for supervision is at least 300 hours for all candidates, NPAP requires that a candidate continue in supervision after meeting the requirement for the duration of training.

- A candidate in training rarely completes only 300 hours of supervision.
- The number of hours of supervision will vary depending on the length of time a candidate takes to complete the training program.
- Supervision fees for candidates in the LQ track are set by NPAP at \$55 per session.
- Already licensed candidates arrange their supervision fees directly with their supervisor.
- These fees may vary widely. A supervision fee of \$50 would result in a minimum supervision cost of \$15,000 for 300 hours.
- While candidates in the LQ track must work with their patients at NPAP's TRCC clinic, already licensed candidates are allowed to gain clinical experience in their private practices. Thus, patient fees that they set and collect are their private business.
- Already licensed candidates also bear the expense of office rent, insurance, and other practice incidentals.
